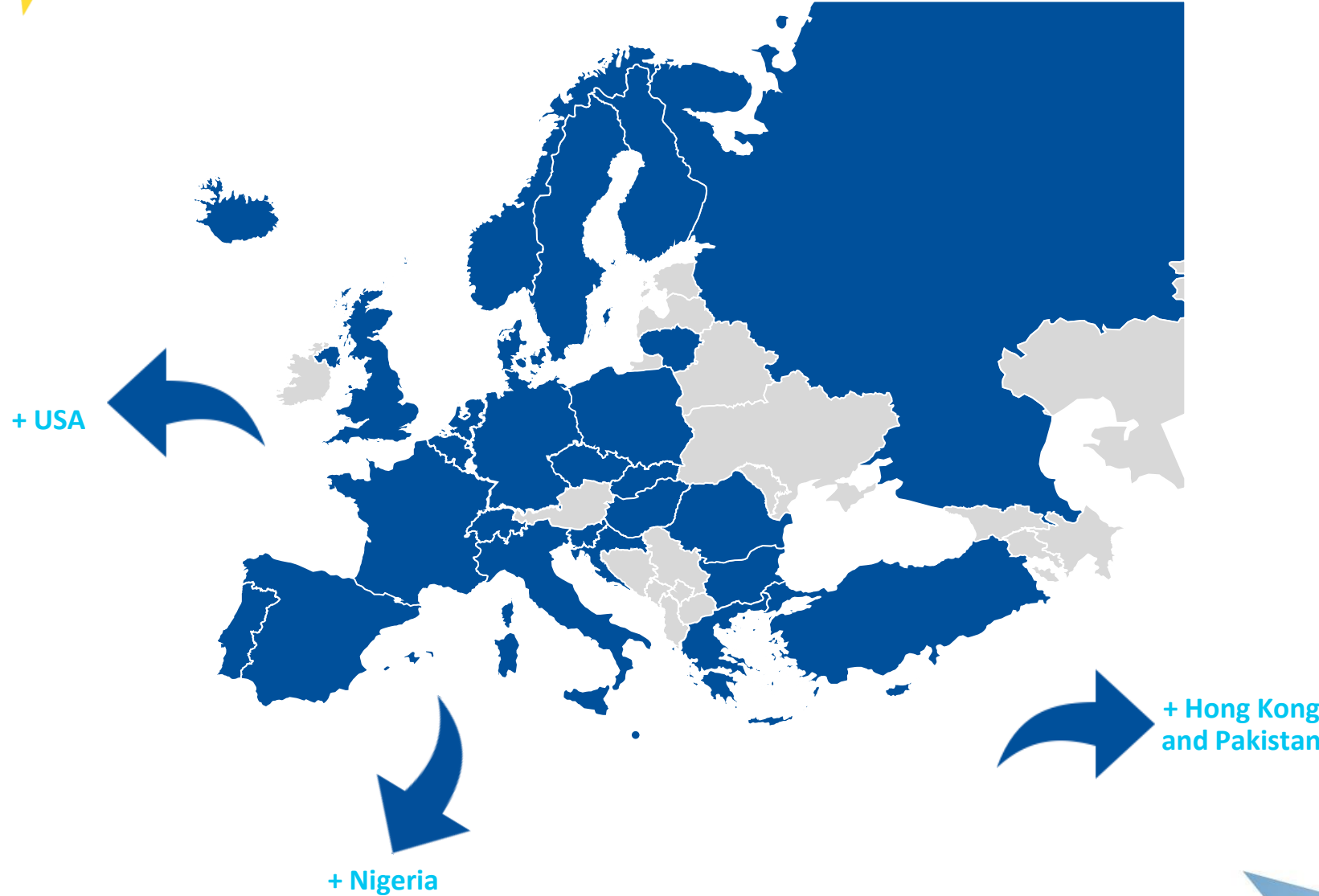
**Mission:** EfVET aims at enhancing VET provision across all members through an active networking of all the key actors. To create the capacity to influence policy at European and National level.

## SELFIE for work-based learning in VET (SELFIE WBL)

**SELFIE WBL** tool and supporting the research component. The National coordinator works very closely with School coordinators providing ongoing support. The National coordinator has a pivotal role in the Piloting Process for the ongoing support to VET schools and companies

*In May 2020, the Joint Research Centre launched a call for tenders for Piloting SELFIE for work-based learning contexts in VET (SELFIE WBL).*

*The call was intended to target 3 countries specifically: **Germany (LOT 1), France (LOT 2), Hungary and Poland (LOT 3).***

*The aim of this Tender is to conduct pilot studies of SELFIE WBL in Germany, France, Poland, and Hungary to test the tool and receive feedback in view of improving it before its eventual online launch. More specifically, the goal is to develop, implement and validate the SELFIE WBL tool that can be useful to VET schools, companies and policymakers at local, regional, national or EU level.*
